Frequently Asked Questions

What areas are eligible for RiverTowne Country Club resident memberships? Any home or property beyond the RiverTowne Country Club marquis on or off of RiverTowne Country Club Drive (excluding the Planter's Point Indigo Chase development) is considered RiverTowne Country Club property. Any homes outside of this area are considered non-resident. The Planter's Point communities and RiverTowne on the Wando community are not considered RiverTowne Country Club property. Non-resident memberships are available for prospective members living outside of RiverTowne Country Club.

Is the Club private or semi-private?

RiverTowne Country Club is a semi-private club. The golf course and restaurant are open to the public. The Club is also available to host outside golf tournaments, weddings, and parties. The Club's social activities are limited to members and their guests only, unless otherwise determined by the Club.

Are there initiation fees?

Yes, there are initiation fees for all levels of membership.

When are dues billed?

Monthly dues are billed at the end of each month for that current month. Dues and charges are then tendered to the credit cards on file on the 8th of the following month i.e.– January dues and charges are billed to the credit card on file on February 8th.

Are the tennis courts and pool Club amenities?

No, the tennis courts and the pool are community amenities. You must be a homeowner within the community to use the tennis courts or pool.



What social activities does the Club offer?

The Club has regular social activities each month as well as additional special events throughout the year. Regular monthly events include Team Trivia, Wednesday Theme Dining, Ladies Nights, Wine Clubs and more. The Club also hosts events such as wine dinners, kids' movie nights, holiday brunches, harbor cruises, a holiday party, shopping expos, comedy nights, dances, and karaoke.

How do I make a tee time?

Tee times can be made by calling the golf shop directly. 843-849-2400.

Does the Club have locker rooms?

Yes, the men's and ladies' locker rooms are located on the first level of the Club. Both locker rooms are equipped with toilets, sinks, showers, lounge areas and lockers. Only full members are eligible for lockers. The lockers are assigned by the Club.

Does the Club offer club storage?

No, the Club does not have space available for club storage.

Are there practice facilities?

Yes, we have a dual-directional driving range, chipping green, and putting green. These facilities are only open to members and day guests. A range fee is appli cable for social memberships when not playing a round of golf. The back range is the member's only range.

What is the range fee for social members?

The fee to use the range when not playing a round of golf is \$7.50 a for a bag of range balls or \$15 for unlimited range balls per session. Complimentary use of the range is included with each paid round of golf.



Can guests play with members and is there a special rate for them?

Yes, we offer preferred rates for guests of full members when they are playing with members. The guest of member rate is \$55.

Are there walking privileges?

Walking is a full Member's only privilege and is at the discretion of the golf shop.

Is the course ever closed?

We do schedule regular maintenance of the golf course that may require the clo sure of the course until the maintenance is completed. Scheduled maintenance dates are subject to change due to the weather.

The course may also be reserved for an outside tournament that restricts access to the course.

Does the Club allow members to use their personal carts?

Yes, the Club allows full resident members to use approved personal carts in accordance with a trail fee. All carts must be the same make, model, and color of our current golf cart fleet and must be approved by the Director of Golf.

Members who use their personal carts are also charged a monthly "trail fee." Social members are not eligible to participate in the trail fee program.

What is the monthly trail fee?

The monthly trail fee varies depending on membership type.

Individual (without gratuity)	\$100.00 plus tax
Family (without gratuity)	\$141.67 plus tax



When is the golf shop open?

The golf shop is opens at 8:30 am Monday-Thursday and at 7:30 am Friday-Sunday. The golf shop closes at 6:30 during daylight savings hours and at 5:30 pm during non-daylight savings hours.

What are the range hours?

Is there a food and beverage minimum?

At this time, we have not instituted a food and beverage minimum. This policy is subject to change at the Club's discretion.

Where is the restaurant and when is it open?

The restaurant is located inside the Clubhouse on the 1st and 2nd level. The restaurant is open to the public for lunch Tuesdays through Saturdays and for dinner Wednesdays - Fridays. A brunch menu is also offered on Sundays. You may make reservations by calling 843-849-2415.
